TINAJANI

The Canyon

Shaped by wind and time, Tinajani is a red rock canyon known as the Valley of the Giants—where stone guardians rise from ancient silence.

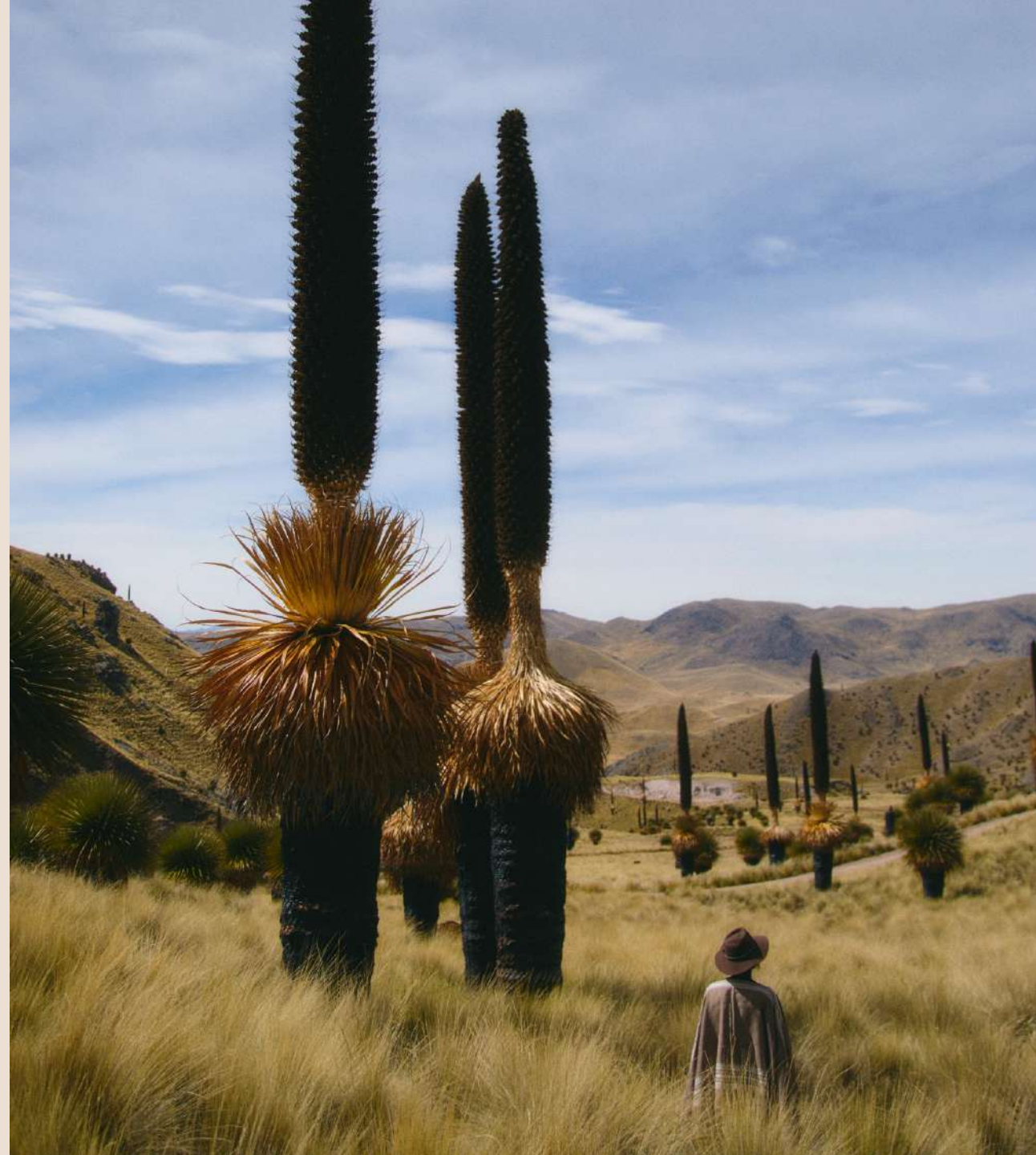

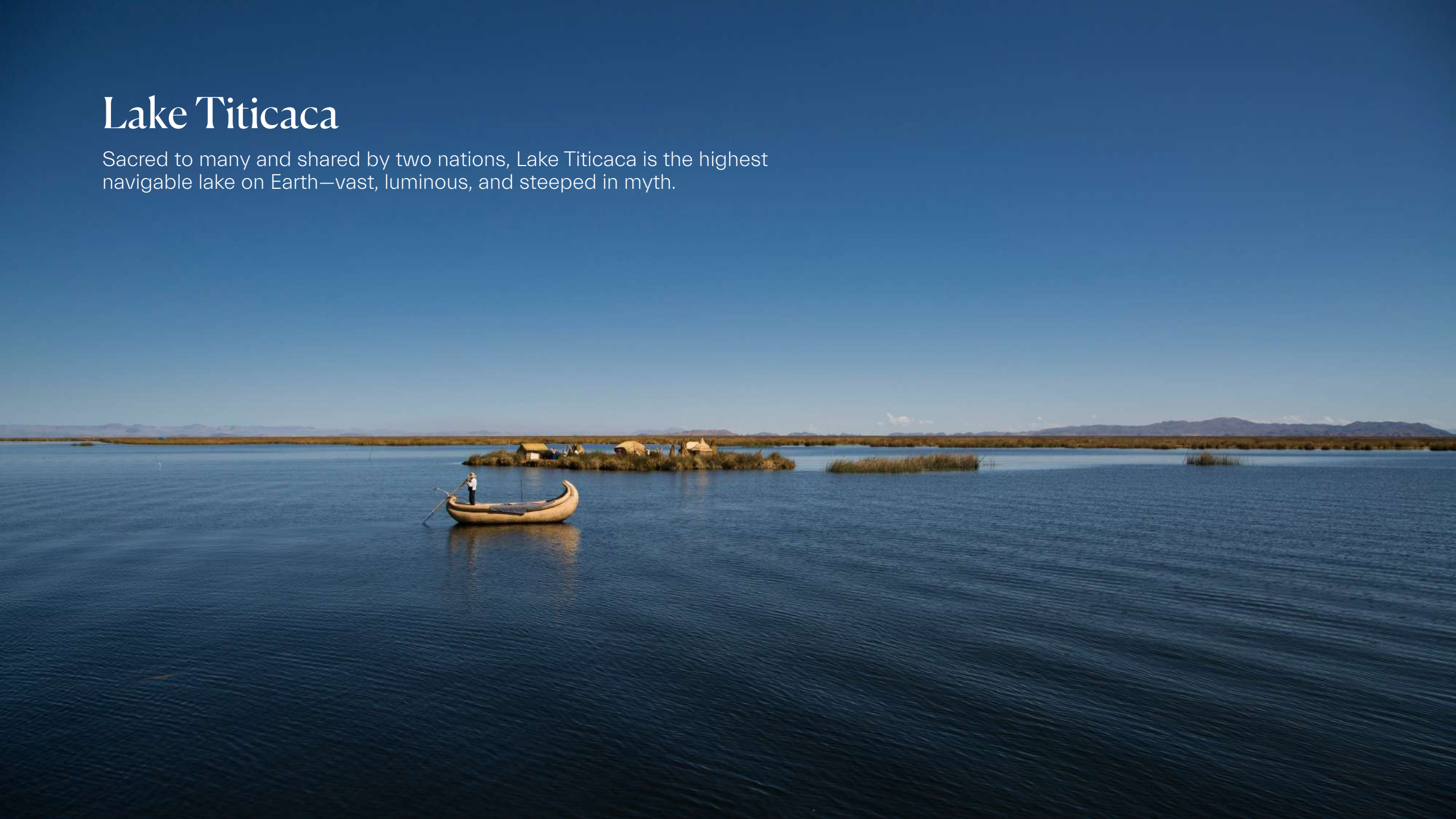

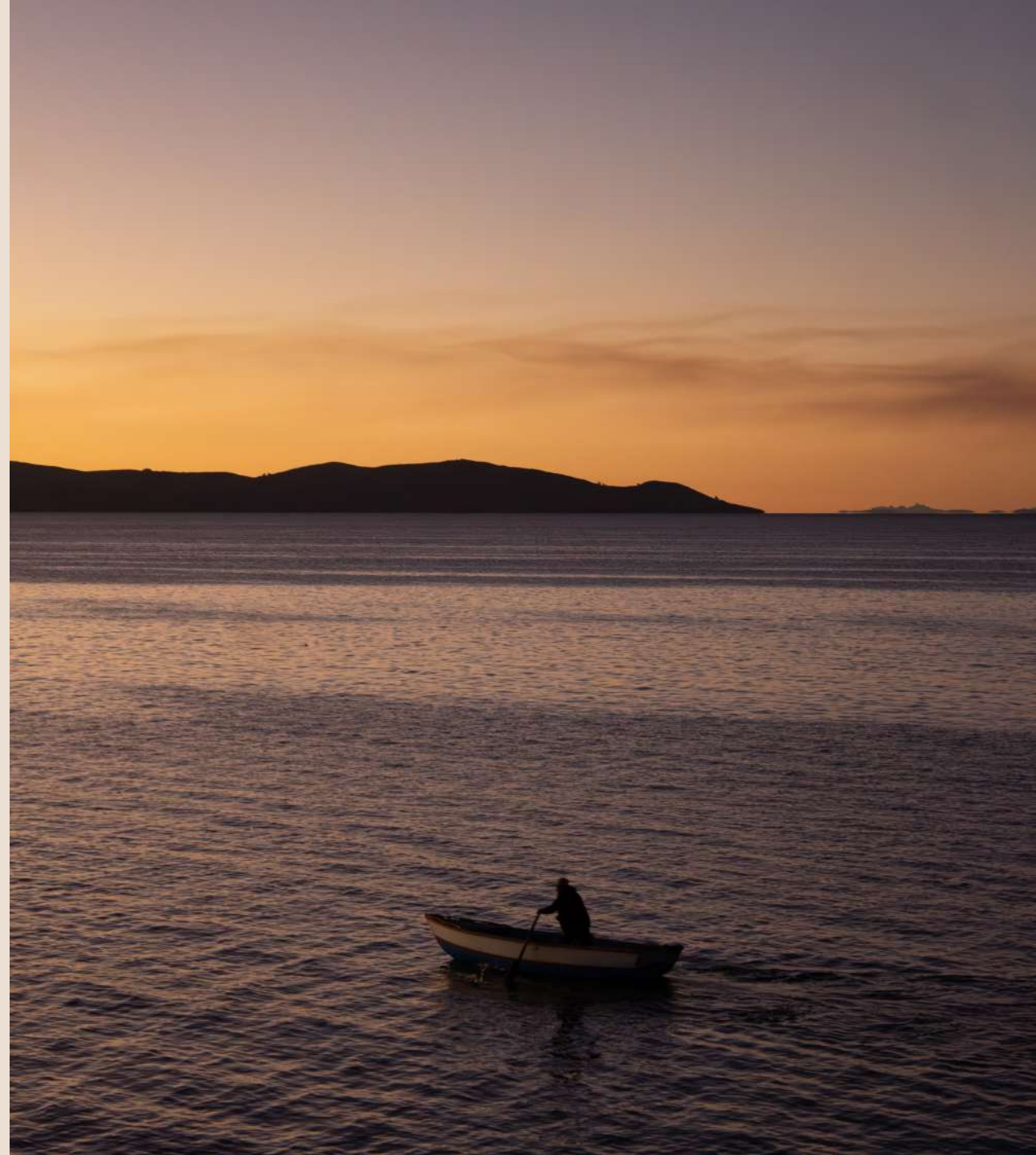
